Dear Chairman Cole,

The First Amendment ensures that the free speech rights of Americans are protected, especially when criticizing government officials and other powerful interests. The Biden Administration is attempting to invert this principle and instead use the power and resources of the federal government to silence its critics.

The Biden administration has been brazen in its efforts to censor political opposition under the guise of mis-, mal-, and disinformation. We applaud you for making the protection of free speech rights a top priority by defunding the Biden censorship regime.

You and Speaker Johnson have demonstrated an unprecedented commitment to preserving the First Amendment. Under your leadership, the Appropriations Committee has included language to defund unlawful censorship programs across the government. As the subcommittees and the full committee continue to do their work, we encourage you to zero out funding for these initiatives in the following offices:

Because this censorship is ubiquitous, we are pleased that you have incorporated blanket language to prohibit any form of censorship of US citizens. We would encourage your committee to adopt this blanket language across all bills and to continue fighting against the left's effort to silence free speech rights.
